Upcoming task and deliverable:

Discussion of the preparation of the up-coming task: Mapping of European plastic waste streams and roadmap of European recyclers (D2.2)

Deadline: 30 August 2023

• First step: Mapping of the waste stream and recyclers in each partner's country

The partners will conduct further research on these topics and provide a list of recyclers and of main polymer waste being recycled (if possible with the amount of each type of waste) by the **end of January 2023.**

WFG will prepare a survey on the knowledge, services or products and especially the interests / objectives in recycling of the identified SME members and the materials that may be exchanged between value chains, within and across sectors (D3.3). Each partner will disseminate the survey to its SMEs and the results will be collected by the end of January 2023 and will help to build the mapping.

• **2nd step**: Mapping of the European recyclers and waste

POL will together with PCD and WFG schedule a meeting with Plastics Europe Recyclers to present the POLREC project. We plan to discuss synergies, collect public data and information available on European waste and recyclers. Moreover, we would like to collect potential contact information on relevant clusters and main recyclers located in other European countries than the ones covered by the consortium. The meeting shall be scheduled before the 20th of December 2022.







A meeting with the project's partners will be scheduled in February 2023 to compile the results from the partners research, the survey, and meetings with Recyclers Plastic Europe and to draft a first version of the D2.2 mapping.

5. Preparation of later tasks in WP2

Later task: Mechanical recycling of plastic waste fractions (T2.3)

Duration and deadline : From month 12 to month 24

• First step: Organising the open calls and voucher system

Decision of the partners to organise 2 cut-off for each open call (separated by at least 6 months) and not continuous open call. PCD suggests to organise the chemical and meachanical open calls at the same time. This is suggested to avoid capacity problems at the recyclers: The partners need to investigate this possibility further among their recyclers to see if this is preferable for SMEs. Decision at the next meeting in February 2023.

Total amount per voucher: Needs to be publicized and communicated to attract SME, but if the project has to support the total number of SMEs for each open call, the partners must keep in mind, that the grant will be lower for most of the SMEs. There is an increasing concern about the raise of energy prices that raises the cost of mechanical and chemical recycling, making the voucher potentially less attractive for SMEs.

Duration of the voucher : 6 months

Payment procedure: 40% up front and 60% after the reception of the test results from the service provider/ SMEs. A short test report from the service-provider and the SMEs will be asked after the recycling is done.

Issues to further investigation:

- Does the project have to support the total number of SMEs indicated in the POLREC proposals document for each voucher? Or can it be lowered?

- How should the procedure for the SMEs that do not comply be set up? Returning the money + 10%? . POL will rely on peer-learning with other euroclusters to see what are the best-practices concerning this issue and implement them in the frame of POLREC project.

- Is a company allowed to work on a voucher and apply for one as well? The partners would like to make it possible for a service-provider to be paid by a voucher to mechanically recycle polymer waste and also be able to apply for a voucher to chemically recycle one of their own waste frations that cannot be recycled mechanically.

This especially applies to SMEs working in value chains.

Application and management system of the cascade-funding must be done by the 31st of May 2023.

• 2nd step : Organising the first open-call

Shall be organise during the last trimester of 2023. Further details will be discussed during the next WP2 meeting.







6. Next meeting

Scheduled on the 9th of February 2023, will take place virtually. PCD will send a TEAMS invitation to all the partners.

PCD will with the support of WFG work on a first draft of the <u>Mapping of European plastic waste streams</u> and roadmap of European recyclers (D2.2) that will be shown and discussed upon during the 2nd WP2 meeting.

Preparation of later tasks in WP2 - Setup of voucher system

- We must discuss how to set up the voucher system:
 - No. of open calls 2 calls have been suggested?
 - Max 30,000€ to be spent by one company this makes only 8 vouchers is 10,000€/ 12,500€ a better amount?
 - Duration max. 1 year
 - Penalty if the voucher is not used
 - 60% payment up front & 40% upon completion has been suggested
 - Can a company work on a voucher and receive one as well?
 - Application format and max. length
 - Evaluation criteria regarding the best applications







Preparation of later tasks in WP2 - Setup of voucher system

- Further to be discussed:
 - 10% of vouchers outside partner countries the rest divided equally among partners – regardless of quality of applicatio
 - If one partner cannot use its vouchers it can be given to another partner but how?
 - The final output a short test report from the service provider to be part of a larger report?
 - Reimburcement of cost maximum the amount of the voucher?
 - Final workshop where results are shown?
